



# FIRE PREVENTION TIPS FOR HARBOUR AUTHORITIES

**Fires are one of the most common incidents on our harbours. There are few ways in which the harbour authority and the users can help prevent fires.**

## **Know what to do.**

Have an up-to-date emergency procedures and correct contact for local fire department and other emergency services.

---

## **Conduct inspections.**

Inspect regularly any electrical boxes and connections. Contact the power company if you see any issues.

---

## **Have fire extinguishers.**

Have fire extinguishers or water pumps readily available. Be mindful of their placement, as the elements may damage them and hinder their functionality.

---

## **Install fire alarms.**

Install and check fire alarms regularly. Replace batteries and follow manufacturing guidelines.

---

## **Install proper signage.**

Indicate where the:

- Muster point and
- Smoking areas are located on the property.

---

## **Require proof of insurance.**

Ensure that proof of insurance is provided when signing any agreement with a user or third party.
